Code of Conduct

The Macedon Ranges Photographic Society (MRPS) aims to provide a safe, welcoming, and inclusive space where people of all backgrounds and identities can come together to share their passion for photography.

We actively promote and maintain behaviours that ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all individuals. To support this we have developed a Code of Conduct (Code) to ensure our members and guests recognise the importance of respecting each other and those around us. This Code applies to all events associated with MRPS, such as meetings, exhibitions, activities and includes MRPS-related online meetings and social media, such as Facebook, Cluster, etc.

- We welcome, support and respect people regardless of race, ethnicity, sex, sexual orientation, marital and family status, disability, political opinion, or economic status.
- We treat others fairly and reasonably.
- We promote a culture of respect and inclusion by engaging in behaviour that is free from offensive, racist, degrading, malicious or sexist language or actions and by avoiding any form of verbal, physical, social or psychological harm to others
- We do not engage in activities, behaviour or conduct that jeopardises the health and/or safety of others.
- We respect the public and private facilities that are provided for members and MRPS events and not wilfully cause damage to those facilities, or the property of others
- We focus on:
 - Treating others with respect;
 - Being honest, impartial, and conscientious when involved in MRPS activities;
 - Ensuring all decisions are made ethically;
 - Ensuring the principles of natural justice are observed.

Competition etiquette

- All competitions will be run in a friendly and supportive environment;
- Members agree to show respect toward fellow competitors, club members, judges, and competition organisers;
- Members agree to support and respect those individuals carrying out their duties on behalf of MRPS. In the event of any issues or disagreements arising from competitions whether internal or external, the ultimate decision rests with the Competition Steward on behalf of the Club Committee.

It is the responsibility of all members and guests of MRPS to follow these guidelines. Try to resolve any issues that may arise in a respectful, co-operative way. The Committee can be called upon to assist to resolve disagreements. In certain circumstances, the Committee may decide further action is required under the Grievance or Disciplinary provisions of MRPS's Rules of Association.
