

MRPS Equine Photography & Safety Walkabout

This walkabout is designed especially for those members who are thinking about heading to the Riddells Creek Easter Horse Trials to take photographs and who have a limited background with horses. I will cover aspects such as:

- what to look out for when near horses and some understanding of what can trigger a dangerous situation
- how to recognise when a horse is becoming nervous or potentially dangerous to the rider or spectators
- the opportunity to photograph a horse in action (this will be in an arena - no jumping) and to learn about what makes a good action horse shot
- some information about the Easter Horse Trials competition in particular

Please note that:

- numbers will be capped at 20 in total to keep the horses, photographers and riders safe
- this may be made up of two separate groups of up to 10 at two different times
- a waiting list will be created for those who miss out
- final details of the group or groups times will be advised after registrations close, but will run somewhere between approximately 10.30am and 1pm
- the location is in Bolinda (ten mins/12 kms from Riddells Creek), just off the Melbourne- Lancefield Road.

All details about exact times, parking, what to bring and location will be emailed to those who have registered once the final numbers are in.
